## A Proclamation for a publick THANKSGIVING.



PON Consideration of the infinite Goodness of GOD, and the Care of his merciful Providence over us, manifested in the innumerable undeserved Blessings beste ved upon us in the Course of the past Year, which demand our most humble and thankful Acknowledgments;

have thought fit, with the Advice of his Wasesty's Council, to order and appoint Thursday the Seventeenth Day of November next, to be observed thro'out this Prevince as a Day of publick THANKS GIVING; erhorting both Ministers and People religiously to attend the same by effering up to Almighty GDD, the Father of Percies, their devout and lincere Prailes, for the great and inclimable Favours conferred on a linkul and undeserving People; Particularly, In preserving his MAJESTY's Life and health under great Dangers, as also the Life and health of his Royal Consort our most gracious QUEEN, With their Royal Highnesses the Prince and Princess of Wales, the Duke, and the rest of the Royal Family; In directing this Pajesty's Councils for the preservation of Beace Within Hiskingdoms and Dominions, and in so great a measure, maintaining the Tranquility of Europe; In prospering the Administrations of the Sovermenent within this Province; In prolonging the leace of our Boiders, and protesting our Navigation from the Ravages of Piraces; In continuing and restoring Health to most of the Tollins of this province; As also, In giving us so plentiful a Harvelt, notivithstanding the threatning Aspeas of Providence in the immoderate Rains and Cold of the Spring foregoing; and in the continuance of our invaluable Privileges, religious and civil, With many other Percies, which lay us under indispentible Obligations to Gratitude and Diedience, and to Fear the LORD and His Goodness. And all servile Labour is fozbidden on the said Day.

Given at the Council Chamber in Salisbury, the Eighteenth Day of Oldober 1 7 3 7. In the Eleventh Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Second, by the Grace of GOD of Great-Britain, France and Ireland, KING, Defender of the Faith, &c.
