A PROCLAMATION

for Apprehending Gyles du Lake Tidmarsh.

The Read Sples du Lake Tidmarth of Boston, did on the Twenty-sisth Day of Otober last, in a most violent and outragious manner with Force and Arms assault and abuse and Institution Brattle, Esq; a Member of the House of Representatives, for some Discourse of the said Institution Brattle upon a Debate had that Day in the said House; Which Assault and Abuse the Great and General Court or Assembly of this Province then sitting did resent as an high Affront and Indignity offered to themselves as well as to that Member, and did accordingly pass an Order requiring the Sherists of the several Counties in this Province and their Officers to apprehend the Body of the said Sples bullake Tidmars, and to have him before the Court to answer for the said Crime; And whereas the said Sples bullake Tidmars, has thereupon absconded and fled from Justice;

have therefore thought bit, at the Request of his Pajetty's Council and the house of Representatives, to illue footh this proclamation, hereby Requiring all sheriffs, Ander-Sheriffs, Constables, and other his Pajesty's Officers, to make diligent Search and Inquiry after the late Gyles du Lake Tidmarsh, and him to apprehend and bring before One or more of his Pajesty's Justices of the Searce, that so he may be had before the Great and General Court or Assembly to answer for his said Crime. And as a Reward for the good Service of such Officer or Officers, or of any other of his Pajesty's good Subjects that shall apprehend and secure the said Gyles du Lake Tidmarsh, and render him to Justice as aforesaid, there shall be also did and paid to such Person or Persons the Sum of Fifty Pounds out of the publick Areasury of this Province.

Given at the Council Chamber in Boston, the Nirth Day of November 1 7 3 3, in the Seventh Year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord G E O R G E the Second, by the Grace of GOD of Great-Beitain, Trance and Ireland, KING, Defender of the Faith, &c.
