

## A Proclamation.



Theving pleased Almighty GOD, to assist our Essorts, in Defence of our Religion and Liberty, against the common Enemies of both, and, with a visible Hand, to support the just Cause of His Majesty's Arms, notwith-standing our Unworthiness: It is our Duty, not only to return our sincere Thanks for these unmerited Favours, but also to pray for His Grace, that we may be enabled, in some Degree, to commend ourselves to the further Care of his Divine Providence. Wherefore, I Have thought

it proper to appoint; and I DO, by and with the Advice of His Majesty's Council, appoint Friday the Thirtieth Day of this Instant March, to be a Day of Falling and Humiliation; whereon all Ministers of the Gospel within this Province, with their several Congregations, shall prostrate themselves before the Throne of the Divine Mercy, humbly imploring Forgiveness for our manifold Sins, and carnestly beseeching Almighty God, to continue his gracious Aid and Assistance to us, who, without Him, are but weak Mortals, until the Work of our Deliverance shall be finished. And I do further Command and Enjoin all civil Magistrates and Officers, to take Order that the said Day be duly observed, as a Day set apart for the Service of GOD; and that no service Labour be performed by any Person on the same.
