Algoroully to Profecute the faid Wast by Sea and Land; And so Effectually to Reduce that Lingdom to us due Obedience, that Their Pajesties good Subjects there may not only be veletued from the present Force and Algorence, but be Secured against all-such Aggressions for the Junuose, and be Settled in assumant lating State of Seace, Sasety and Property: For Which Hurpose his Pajesty hath Determined to make a Royal Aoyage and go thicker in Herson, putting his Trust in Almighty God (who hath by his Parvellous Providence histerto Preserved and Conduced his Pajesty) that he will Clouchiase a special Birding on this his Aighteous Andertaking, and thereby Consummate the Delibertance of these Kingdoms. Their Pajesties taking the Premises into Their most ferious Consideration have thought fit to Appoint, and do by and wirth the Advice of Their Priby Council, hreedy Appoint and Command a Seneral and Publick Hast and humiliation to be Observed throughout this Realm in most Debout and Solemm manner, so Supplicating Almighty God so, Pardon of our Sins, and Imploining his Bissing and krotetion in the Prebation of his Pajesties Access Person, and Prosperity of his Arms in Ireland, and the Padual Forces, to be Artigiously Rept and Observed on Wednesday the Twelsth Day of March nert, throughout Their Pajesties Kingdom of England, Dominion of Wales, and Colun of Berwick upon Tweed, and thenessociated be Observed on the Third Wednesday in every Ponth successively During the present State. And so the more wherehy Solemusing of the sole several Fast Days, Their Pajesties have given Directions to the Right Rederend the Bishops of this Kingdom, to Compose a Foun of Prayers suitable to this Decasion, to be used in all Churches and Chappels, and other Places of Publick Another, and have given Charge for the Dispersing thereof through their species in the Uhrle Kingdom: And Their Pajesties do most Expectly Charge and Command, that the said Fastings and Payers be Soberty, Rederently and Decently Personned by all Their Loding Subje
