

By the Honorable STEPHEN HOPKINS, Esq; Covernor, Captain-General, and Commander in Chief, of and over the English Colony of Rhode-Island, and Providence-Plantations, in New-England, in AMERICA.

A PROCLAMATION.

LL, who acknowledge GOD's moral Government of the World, believe that the Sins of Mankind draw down his Judgments upon them. And, as the English Colonies on this Continent, are fallen under the chastising Hand of HEAVEN, who has permitted the barbarous and cruel Savages of the Wildernels, to spoil and destroy their Borders, to murder their young Men, and to carry their Sons and Daughters into the most calamitous Captivity; and are threat'ned with Wars, still more general, and Judgments, which portend their utter Satispation: Under such Circumstances, Resion suggests, and Revelation demonstrates, that our whole Sasety depends on deeply humbling ourselves before GOD, succeedy sepenting of our Sins, and religiously resolving to selorm our Lives and Actions for the Time to come.

SUCH Considerations, moved the General Agendby of the said Colony, to direct mento proclaim Thursday, the twentieth of this Instant May, to be observed as a Day of FASTING and RATER, throughout the Colony, and that no service Labor be done on that Day; but that all Societies of Christians, within the same, assemble themselves together, at their several usual Places of public Worship, and there humbly Address the Throne of Grace, for the Preservation of Grorge the Second, cur present King, of his ROYAL FAMILY, of the BRITISH CONSTITUTION, and of the PRACE and SAFRTY of all his COLOMINE; and principally, that we may break off from our Sins, by hearty Repentance, and may average the Judgments of GOD, and obtain his Favor, by true Amendment of Life. AND I do hereby Order, that the said twentieth Day of May, be observed as a Day of FASTING and PRAYER, throughout this Colony, and strictly require all the Inhabitants thereof, to abstain from all service Labor, and duly conform themselves to all that is above-written.

GIVEN under my Hand, at Providence, the twelfth Day of May, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty-fix, and in the Twenty-ninth Year of His Mujesty's Reign.
