A PROCLAMATION for a general FAST.

Beneas in the midit of many Monderful Mercies wherewith the Divine Goodness hath surrounded us, this Probince is attended with very notable Causes of Humiliation and Supplication.

T is therefore Ordered, That Thursday the Three and Twentseth of March next be set apart for the Duties of extraozdinary PRAYER with FASTING before the Lord; That through, our Lord IESUS CHRIST, imploring the Pardon and Redress of the Sins offenlive to the Eyes of his Glory among us, we may also obtain the manifold Bleslings of the Almighty upon all our Affairs in the Pear ensuing; That the expected Arrival of his EXCELLENCY our Governour unto this part of his Government, may be under the Care and Smile of Beaben; That all our Concerns both by Sea and Land, and particularly those of the Husbandry, may be prospered; That our Peace and Health may be continued: And above all. That plentiful Effulions of the Spirit of Grace upon all Oeders among us, may prepare us for the Salvations of our God; With further and ferbent Betitions, That our Soveraign Lord the KING may be preferbed, and his Kingdoms with his Parliaments in them Enjoy the happy Symptoms of God Returning with Favour to the Nations: That the Flock of our Lord Jefus Christ where 'tis Languishing under horrible Persecutions, may be Delibered; And that the Interest of his True Religion may exceedingly prevail in all, and particulariy in the American parts of the Earth.
