have therefore thought fit, by and with the Advice of the Council, to appoint, and no hereby appoint Michaelday the Eighth day of April next, to be Observed as a day of publick Fasting and Ima year throughout this Colony; ernorting both Ministers and people deply to humble themselves before the Lord under a fense of our manifold Sins that have provoked his Displeasure against us,

and earnestly to supplicate the turning away of his Wrath from us. And also that servent supplications be made to Almighty GOD, That he Would blels, prolper and preferve Our Sovereign Loid King G & O R G B, Their Ropal Dighnesses the PRINCE and PRINCESS of Wales, and the rest of the ROYAL Family; That all the publick Affairs of our Nation may be under the Conduct and Smiles of beaven: That GOD would direct and bless his Wajelip's Counfels. fuceed his Arms in the rule and necessary War he is ingaged in ; Checially that Success and Under may attend his Wajelly's Foices in the West-Indies, that God would preferve them from Sin, Sickness and the danger of the Seas, cover their beads in the day of Battle, and give them the Chield of his Salvation, and that the present War may specily terminate in a just and honourable Peace; That GOD would guard our Sea Coalis, relieve us under our Diftreffes, haften and blefs the Springing of the Pear; preferbe our Civil and Religious Privileges, and bil appoint all unjust disturbers of the public's Peace: That GOD would viels the Hagiltracy and Hiniltry, smile upon our College, and preferbe peace and purity in our Churches, and fucced means used for Christianizing the Remains of the India Natives of this Land, and that the divine Blefung may attend our husbandin.
