A PROCLAMATION.

REVERING the wise and pious Example of our venerable Forefathers, in their Institution of appropriate

Days to be set apart for solemn, social and religious Duties:

March next, to be observed throughout this State, as a Day of PUBLIC FASTING, HUMIL-IATION and PRAYER. And I do hereby recommend to Ministers and People of all Denominations, in their solemn assemblies, and in their private retirements, to attend devoutly to the religious Duties of the Day; particularly to recollect, and seriously to reflect upon the many and various Sins whereby we provoke the just displeasure of a Holy GOD, who hateth all Iniquity, and will punish with His righteous Indignation every Sinner who continueth unrepentant in his sinful and ungodly Deeds:—to consider and lament, our public and national, as well as private and individual Errors and Vices, which are displeasing to GOD, and injurious to ourselves and to our Country:—To add also to these reflections our sincere Repentance for all our Sins and Backslidings from the ways of Truth, Virtae and Righteousness; devoutly imploring; through our Great Mediator, the pardoning Mercy of our GOD for past offences, and His Divine Influence and Aid in our future conduct and walk before HIM.

At the same time, let us offer our joint and fervent petitions to Almighty GOD, the GOD of our Fathers, for HIS Blessing on our Persons, our State, our Nation and Land.—That HE would afford us the Influences of HIS Divine Grace, and the Guidance of HIS Holy Spirit;—That HE would enlighten us in the Knowledge of HIS Mind and Will; more especially as regards our Religious Duties towards our GOD, and to our fellow men, and make us conscientiously observant of our several Duties and Relations:—That HE would continue to us, in its purity, the Enjoyment of HIS blessed Gospel, and lead the People to a careful and faithful observance of its Doctrines, Precepts and Institutions:—That HE would bless our Ministers of the Gospel, and make them wise and prudent Expositors of HIS revealed Truths:—Regard with HIS peculias Grace and Favor the Youth of our Land, the rising Generation, to which end, that HE would bless our Colleges and all Schools of Learning, and cause that they be furnished with pious and upright Professors, Teachers and Instructors, who, in aid of the Parents' early endeavors, may faithfully store the minds of the Youths with the Doctrines of Religion and Morality, as well as instruct them in the knowledge of common Learning, Arts, Sciences and their social Duties .- Also that our God would smile on and prosper the public and private concerns of the United States and of this State :- That HE would grant HIS special presence with and direction to the President of these United States, and superintend the general welfare of the Nation. That HE would bless the Administration of this State, and succeed its Counsels and all our public Concerns. Smile on the lawful Industry of our People in their various Labors and Employments, and make us to rejoice in general Health, Plenty and Peace. Harmonize the minds of the People in the pursuit of their best Interests, -the cause and practice of Religion, Morality, civil order and Righteousness. That HE would enlighten all Nations with the Influences of HIS Gracious Gospel ;-enlarge the hearts of men with Love and universal Benevolence, and fill the Earth with HIS Glorious Goodness,
