And I do hereby earnestly recommend to, and exhort all Persons residing within the First he in motion fame, to assemble at the usual Place and Places in their respective Towns, Parishes, and Districts, of meeting for social Worship; and with Hearts suitably impressed with the Goodness of GOD, render to him the delightful Tribute of Adoration and Praise, for Luc DHealth, Competence, Unity, and Peace, and every other Eleffing and Enjoyment, whether 🕼 of Providence or of Grace, national and private; protessing a Dependence upon him as the Author and Bestower of every needful Good; and humbly manifesting a becoming Hope that no useful Blessing, whether of a public or private Nature, will be withheld :---- In a more especial Manner, that, deploring the Infidelity of their Hearts, they devoutly and fincerely acknowledge, adore, and praise the transcendent Goodness of GOD, in the Maniheelth, put festation of redeeming Love, through Jesus Christ our Lord, and the inestable Blessings therein thence derived to Mankind regular their qualitate of the United Net IT is recommended, that the said Day be observed by all Persons with decent Solemnity.
