The Lieutenant GOVERNOUR, Council and Assembly. A Proclamation for a general THANKSGIVING.

ThIS Court taking into ferious Confideration the many great and lignal Mercies of a Gracious GDD, bestowed upon a finfull and Undeferbing people, in sparing and probing of us one Pear moze, notwithstanding our manifold grievous Provocations, and wiful backwardnels in improving his repeated Judgments unto a thozow Reformation; Specially, in that he hath continued our civil and facred Liberties thus far; that he hath in an unexpected manner afforded us a plentifull parvell after several years of scarcity; that he hath continued fuch measures of Health among us, and prevented a contagious mortal Distemper from breaking in upon us when it twice threatened us in the Summer past; that he hath so far given theck to the Rage of our beathen Adberfaries; that be hath fucceeded the Undertakings of our Soveraign Lord the King and made Din the happy Instrument of an honorable Peace after so many years of a confuming War; that he hath put it into his Royal heart to engage in and Arenvoully to pursue Reformation; that under his conduct the three Kingdoms with the Dispersions them doe enjoy the free Liberty of the True Religion, whilest the faithfull in France, Piedmont, and other places, are fuffering hozzible Persecution for the Truth: Belides innumerable more Kindnelles of our Mercifull GDD calling us to lignalize our Gratitude unto Dim.

Therefore it is Ordered, and this Court doth hereby Order and Appoins that Thursday the Fifteenth of December next, be kept as a Day of solemn THANKSGIVING throughout this pervince; And that the Pinisters and People address themselves to this heavenly Employment in such a manner, as that an acceptable Sacrifice of Praise may be offered to GOD through Jesus Christ. And all Service Labour is hereby forbidden upon said Day.
