A PROCLAMATION.

HEREAS it is the unquestionable Duty of all Men to confess their Sins against the Creator and Preserver of the Universe, humbly to implore His Mercy and Forgiveness, and to offer up to Him Praises and Thanksgivings, for the many unmerited Favours and Blessings He hath bestowed upon us:

AND WHEREAS the GENERAL ASSEMBLY, at their Session on the last Monday in October last, passed an Act, appointing Thursday the Twenty-Eighth Instant to be observed as a Day of Public Prayer, Praise and Thanksgiving; and requested me to issue a Proclamation accordingly:

I HAVE THEREFORE thought fit to iffue this Proclamation, to make known the faid Act; and to call upon the Citizens of this State to affemble themselves together on that Day, in their usual Places of public Worship, to offer up their united Prayers, Praises and Thanksgivings, to ALMIGHTY God, agreeably to the Intention of the said Act. AND I DO earnestly recommend to them, to abstain from all service Labour, and unnecessary Recreations, on that Day.

GIVE N under my Hand, and the Scal of the faid State, this Fourth Day of November, in the Year of our LORD One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety-Three, and of Independence the Eighteenth.
