And all Ministers and Preachers of the word of God, and all other Persons whatsoever within this. Province and dependancyes, as thereby required strictly to observe and keep the same and their Charches or publish meeting houses; as they will answer the contrary at their peril.

Given his Majestis Fore in New York, the 2 st aux of May, in the Eighth Tear of the Reign of our Suverage Lord WILLIAM the Chird King of England, Scotland, France and Iteland, Defender of the Faith, &c. Anno; Domini 1696.
