
A Thanksgiving for the late Victory by His Majesties Naval Forces.

And We look

upon it as an invitation from Beaben to His Bajestie and all his people unto most intire thankfulness for the same. And to the end some solemn time may be set apart for the publick personance of this Duty; and that set and all his Bajesties Subjects throughout this Kingdom, may pay our just tribute of praise and thanksgiving to Almighty God; sele do hereby publish and resare, and also strictly charge and command. That Tuesday the Fourth day of July nert, be set apart and observed as a day of publick Chanksgiving, in and throughout this his Wajesties Kingdom of Ireland. And sele do also direct and appoint, That this Dur Proclamation be publickly read in all Churches and Chappels on the Lords Day precedent to the said day of Chanksgiving hereby appointed to the end that notice may be taken threas, and due thanks and praise may upon the said day be offered unto Almighty God. And that humble supplications be poured out before him, so, his continual affistance and improvement of this, and all his mercies to the homour of his great Pame, and the peace and benefit of his Pajestie and his people, willing and strictly commanding all persons within this his Wajesties Kingdom of Ireland, with all sobriety, reverence and thanksulness to observe that day, as becomes so solemn an occasion.
