A PROCLAMATION For a Day of publick Thanksgiving.

HE favourable and merciful Dispensations of divine Providence, which Almighty GOD in the midst of his righteous Judgments of I all hath Remembred for and Manisested to our Nation and the People of this Land, in bestowing on them many great, tho' forseited Blessings in the currant lear, demand our humble and thankful Acknowlegements of PRAISE to Him whose loving Kindness and tender Mercies endure for ever.

Dave therefore thought fit, by and with the advice of the Council, and at the defire of the Representatives, in General Court Assembled, to appoint, and do hereby appoint Thursday the Ainth Day of November next, to be observed as a Day of publick Thanksgiving throughout this Colony: Exhorting both Bin: steers and People in all their several religious Congregations, with debout and grateful Pinds 10 Bless and Praise the Name of the LORD for his wonderful Works and Mercies to the Children of Men, and to Sing about of

his dinguithing Godnels unto us.
