A PROCLAMATION

For a General Thanksgiving.



ORASMUCH as it has pleased GOD graciously to regard the distressed State of the People of this Province under the late extream Drought (attended with a great Number of noxious Infects) which threatened a general Destruction of the Fruits of the Earth, and to grant us Relief by the plentiful Showers of Heaven whereby the parched Earth has been greatly refreshed and the perishing Fruits revived, and the Insects in some good Measure destroyed, so far as to give us good Hopes that (by

the Continuance of the Divine Blefling) we may have a competent Supply for the N-cessities and Comforts of Life;

nat the Delice of the houle of Representatives, to appoint Thursday the Twent's fourth of August Instant, to be observed throughout this Province as a Day of General Thanksgiving; hereby calling upon Paintsters and People religiously to solutions the same, by offering up their lincere and devoutpraises to Almighty SDD (who is the Father of the Rain, and beyets the Drops of Dew) for this great and scalonable Percy, with humble Acknowledgements of our absolute Dependence upon his Sovereign Pleasure for all Blessings, and one utter Industriness of the least of them; And with their thanksul Praises, to join their humble and servent Supplications for the Continuance of the Divine Boodness in these Respects (as well as all others;) and that SDD would so other the Scalons in the remaining Part of the Wear, that there may be Food sufficient both so, Pan and Beast; And above all, that it would please SDD (who has the Hearts of all Den in his Hands) to sandify all the Dispensations of his Problemce towards us so, promoting a general and unseigned Repentance and Resonation, especially of those hemous Sins which have been the Ground of SDD is righteous Dispicature against us; and that we may be that happy People whose SDD is the UDRD. And all service Labour is souldbeen on the said Day.
