A Proclamation for a General THANKSGIVING



ORASMUCH as amidft the various awful Rebukes of Heaven, with which we are righteoutly afflicted, in the Contagious and Mortal Sickness among us, especially in the Town of Boston; The long and immoderate Basins, which have been so hurtful to the Husbandry and Fishery; And the threaming Aspect of Affairs with Respect to our Frontiers: We are still under the highest and most indispensible Obligations of Gratitude for the many Instances of the divine Goodness in the Favours vouchsafed to us in the Course of the Year past; Particularly, For the LIFE of our Gracious Sovereign Lord the KING. Their Royal Highnesses the Prince and Princess of Unaltes and their Issue, and the increase of the Royal Family; The Preservation of His Majesty's Kingdoms

and Dominions from the terrible and desolating petitience, which hath for so long a Time been wasting the kingdom of france; And the happy Success of His Majesty's Wife Counsils for Restoring & Consiming the Peace of Europe; For the Continuance of our valuable Privileges, both Civil and Ecclesiastical; and the divine Blessing upon this Government in their Administrations; Particularly, In succeeding the Methods taken to prevent the Insults of the Eastern Indians; For giving so great a Measure of Health within this Province, and Moderating the Mortality of the Small Dor, so that a great Number of Persons are Recovered from that Distemper; And sor granting us so commortable a former Harvest, and so hopeful a Prospect of the latter:

have therefore thought but with the Advice of his Hajely's Council, to Order and Appoint Thuriday the Twenty-link of October next, to be Oblevved as a Day of Publick THANKSGIVING throughout this Province, Aricly forbiding all Service Labour thereon, and Exporting both Ministers and People in their respective Assemblies on the said Day, to offer up humble and lineare THANKS to Almighty GOD, for his many favours, as aforesaid, and for many other Bleslings bestowed on a Sinful People.
